### Regulations

#### MIDDLESEX JUNIOR WINTER LEAGUE 2017-18 RULES

The league will be organized into 2 areas, East and West. Within those areas there will be divisions, geographically organized wherever possible.

There are leagues for the following age groups:-

Mixed 8/u  
Mixed 9/u  
Mixed 10/u  
Boys 14/u  
Girls 14/u  
Boys 16/u  
Girls 16/u

All mixed and boys teams are to consist of 4 players. Girls teams are 2 players.  
Mixed teams may have up to 3 boys or girls playing.

The scoring format for the 8/u & 9/u is one 10 point tie break .

The scoring format for all other age groups is best of 3 short sets with any 3rd set being a match tie break .

Two points is to be awarded for each rubber won.

Players must play in order of merit and according to LTA ratings at the time of the match

The fixture list will be posted on the website: <http://lta.tournamentsoftware.com>

The Home team is responsible for contacting the opponents to arrange the fixture. All fixtures must be confirmed by 30 September 2017. If no date has been agreed the match must be played on the play by date as on the web site.

The winning team is responsible for entering the results on line within 48 hours and the losing team must confirm the result within 7 days. Please do not confirm the match if there are any errors either with the names or the score. Instead add a comment to the match.

The Home team is responsible for providing new balls and adequate refreshments for each match.

For uncompleted matches; time of play; late arrival; injuries etc. The same rules will be employed as in the Middlesex Summer League.

The winner of the Division will be determined by the number of points won. In the event of a tie the percentage of games won to those played shall decide.
